## MINUTES OF THE LEISURE ENHANCEMENT COMMITTEE held on MONDAY 20 January 2025

Meeting commenced at 7:00pm



1. **Apologies of absence:** None
2. **Requests for Dispensations, Declarations of Interest, Gifts and Hospitality**
  - TM - Quote for Brickle Park, Item 7as they are his employer.
3. **Open to the public** (Max. 15-minute session):
  - No residents
4. **Councillors to approve and the Chair to sign the minutes of the last Committee Meeting: Monday 25th November 2024**
  - **Proposed:** MB
  - **Seconded:** MD
  - **Agreed by all**
5. **To discuss the Tree Survey**
  - Surveyor walked around all the parks and trees. Highlighted trees that require immediate (red), intermediate (amber) and not action (green)
  - Quote obtained for the works from Roots Tree Surgeons as previous company had retired.
  - Community Payback Team can take the ivy off the trees but not remove it.
  - MW - How long does survey last? How often do we need to do one.
  - BB – no stated legislation.
  - MW – Suggested every 2 years: year 1 do urgent (red), yr 2 the other bits (amber).
  - Concerns we're getting near nesting season and contractors get booked up quickly.
  - Outcome: Focus on Brickle, Old Oak and extra hedgerow.
  - Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL Money) – have we got some left? Do we have to buy an asset with the money. Offsets the carbon monoxide.



- **ACTION:** Clerk to provisionally book contractors for this work and for costs to go to Full Council Meeting for approval.
  - **Proposed:** MW
  - **Seconded:** MD
  - **Agreed by all**
  
- 6. To discuss the Bench at Little London**
  - The bench has fallen into disrepair
  - MD – Charity cannot take it due to its condition.
  - Suggestion for Community Payback Team to remove it from as near to base as possible, asked to break it up and remove to Brickle Park for disposal.
    - **ACTION:** MW to liaise with Community Payback Team
  
- 7. To receive an update on Brickle Pocket Park**
  - Aggregate was being moved however Great Crested Newts found, so works stopped.
  - Bridge works still outstanding – new quote needed
  - Concerns re: dangerous trees, however some clearing works have been carried out by Community Payback Team
  
- To approve quote for fencing works in Brickle Pocket Park
  - This was missed off last Full council meeting – so needs to go back to February meeting for formal approval
    - **Proposed:** MB
    - **Seconded:** MD
    - **Agreed by 4** Councillors, TM abstained.
  
- 8. To receive an update on Olney Pocket Park**
  - To retrospectively note reimbursement of £44.16 to volunteer for cost of infill for steps down to the pond, which was agreed at Full Council meeting on 13.01.2025
  
  - **To discuss the Potential Wildlife Site Survey**
    - Co-ordinated by a volunteer – conclusion, nothing needing protection. Interesting document.
    - Information board needs replacing, with new information reflecting what's in the wildlife survey
    - New barriers requested to prevent unauthorised vehicles, although no clear indication given as to type.
    - **ACTION: JBS to ask Highways what they feel would be the best type of barriers.**
    - Discussion as to whether Community Infrastructure Levy can be used.
    - Concern raised that receipts are being sent to clerk for payment, not authorised. Clerk has written to persons to clarify payments process.
    - **ACTION: Clerk to thank the volunteer for doing the wildlife site survey for us and ask if they can do one for Brickle.**



- **ACTION: Clerk, MB & MW to look at shopping list, meet with the volunteers to ascertain what type of boards/barriers needed.**

**9. To receive an update on the War Memorial**

- It is grade 2 listed so will need planning permission
- Waiting for 2<sup>nd</sup> quote.
- Possibility of gaining grant from War Memorials Trust.

**10. To discuss the Leisure Strategy**

- MD has drafted Terms of Reference (TOR) & Strategy
- MD outlined the TOR, to replace old one which does not reflect what we do now.
- Reviewed what we have done in the last year, looked at TOR from other PC's as well as suggestions from LEC members.
- Brief discussion on how can we encourage community to be involved?
- **ACTION: All comments back to MD. Clerk to share with all Cllrs**
