February 2025 Update.

1. Cash remains stable at positive £50k. However, we do have release the builders retainer of £12k
2. We are preparing our budgets and plans for 2025/2026
3. We need guidance from Parish Council
 - a. How to get registered and or nominated as the village rescue and recovery centre
 - b. How and when to apply for a 2025/2026 grant
4. We have an agreement to lease some land from the Kings that can park c23 cars. The yearly fee is £300. The space is ours but excludes F1 period. The area does need landscaping and gravelling, we are awaiting quotes. Renting the land increases the cost to the SRA and we would like SPC to consider taking this responsibility. It will alleviate the current unacceptable parking position.
5. The SRA has taken a further step forward as being recognised as the inclusive family friendly go to place in the village. It has elevated its presence. However, we really need to resolve the path from the shop to the SRA. How do we do this. I believe it is now a very serious issue. Doing nothing is no longer acceptable.
6. We are 1 month in with Café 74 overall the feed back is good. Some steps to take, but good.
7. We have added a pool table which is generating £50 per week and bringing more footfall to the SRA
8. Tennis and Paddle Ball
